#FSExpoFriday takes place on Friday, June 21 in the Brasilia Ballroom. There will be a single track of presentations livestreamed globally for free across YouTube and other social media platforms. All partners are welcome to share or host the livestream on their social channels; please email us directly for instructions. There is no access to the exhibit hall for attendees on Friday.

Saturday, June 22 and Sunday, June 23


CONFIRM YOUR REGISTRATION

If you wish to test any of your equipment, audio, or the presentation in advance, please feel free to do so at your leisure. No coordination is required for testing; simply show up at your presentation area during the following times.

LOGISTICS INFORMATION FOR YOUR PRESENTATION

We expect speakers to be self-sufficient. Please arrive at your designated seminar area at least 15 minutes before your presentation and check in with the on-site technician. A FlightSimExpo volunteer will also be available at the presentation area as your point of contact for access to the projector, connection questions, microphones, taking questions from the virtual audience, etc.

Audio/Visual Equipment

All rooms will have a wireless presenter (to advance slides) and standard PC A/V connections. Please do not plan for highspeed internet access in speaking rooms and ensure any videos or other content you plan to access are downloaded or available offline.

Session Timing

Generally, 10 minutes has been allocated between presentations for setup. Speakers are responsible for managing their own timeline to ensure presentations begin and end as scheduled on our website. To help us remain on time, please move outside of the presentation area at the conclusion of the presentation; if individual attendees have questions, feel free to continue taking them in a way that does not interfere with the next presenter's time on the stage.



Presentation Materials – For #FSExpoFriday Presenters

If you are presenting a seminar during #FSExpoFriday, send all materials to <u>info@flightsimexpo.com</u> by Tuesday, June 18. Materials will be preloaded onto a computer and will be available to you on-site.

To ensure the session moves at an appropriate pace and avoid technical issues, #FSExpoFriday presenters are asked to send materials in advance rather than use their own computer to project. We can work with you individually if this is an issue for your presentation.

Presentation Materials – For Weekend Seminar Presenters

If you are speaking during any of our weekend seminars, you may either:

- Send materials to info@flightsimexpo.com by June 18. Materials will be presented from the onsite technician's Windows computer.
- Bring materials on a USB drive (materials will be presented from the on-site technician's Windows computer).
- Present materials from your own laptop (standard video/audio connections will be available; if you use a Mac, bring adapters to connect to HDMI).

The experience should be seamless and consistent regardless of which method you choose. We strongly encourage you to take advantage of the pre-arranged audio/visual testing times to ensure all video and audio is working as expected in advance of your live presentation.

There is no required standard branding or formatting for presentations.

Questions & Answers

Based on feedback from previous years, please remember to **repeat any questions** you receive before answering them. Often, other attendees in the room won't be able to hear the original question.

In most cases, expect to manage questions on your own by having attendees stand to ask the question and then repeating it for the audience. If you wish to take questions from a large in-person audience, we can make a FlightSimExpo representative available to pass microphone(s) around the room. Please coordinate with us on-site if you would like our assistance with Q&A.

Don't forget, we also have virtual attendees! We encourage you to include them in your presentation by welcoming their questions. You can ask the on-site A/V technician to feed you any questions that are received from virtual attendees.
